

### Safety Information


- > Before installing the Replacement Emergency Battery or doing any maintenance, ensure power supply is turned off at the circuit breaker or fuse box.




Installation procedure: Carefully read the installation instructions and ensure the mains supply is isolated before installation. Please follow the safety information overleaf before carrying out any installation. Please retain the leaflet for future reference. Important: When installing, leave a space of at least 1.2m between the LED Bulkhead and any heating source/air conditioning unit.

### Gear Tray Emergency Battery Installation:


Step 1: Ensure that the mains supply is disconnected/switched off before commencing any repairs to the product.




Step 2: Disconnect the 3pin battery connector from the Emergency Module.




Step 3: Remove the 2x battery securing screws.



Step 4: Align the replacement Emergency battery with the gear tray fixing holes, then insert the 2x securing screws.



Step 5: Insert the battery connector into the Emergency Module. Ensure that it has connected correctly. The 'Date of Commission' label on the side of the Emergency Battery **MUST** be entered for future testing and reference purposes.



Step 6: Installation is complete. Turn the power on and ensure the unit functions as intended in Standard and Emergency modes. Note: The green emergency LED will illuminate when the EM battery is charging correctly.
