Scope

The ADDER® AVS-2214, AVS-4214, AVS-1124 and CCS-MV4224 switches enable users to interact with up to four dual head computers using a single mouse and keyboard. The operator can simply move the mouse cursor across screen borders to instantly select the computer they need to control providing the experience of a single desktop, saving both time and desk space.

Customer upgrade instructions

The Dual Monitor driver should only be installed on Windows 10 computers

Make sure that you follow the instructions on all the Windows PC's that are connected to the switch to complete the installation of Dual Monitor driver.

Installing a new Dual Monitor driver

1. Install the zip file on each dual head PC
2. Locate installation file, "Adder_Dual_Monitor_Driver.exe"
3. Double click "Adder_Dual_Monitor_Driver.exe"
4. Follow on screen instructions
5. Complete the installation on all dual head PC's connected to the switch

Uninstalling an existing Dual Monitor driver

1. Open Start Menu
2. Click the Cog icon to open Settings
3. Click Apps
4. Either scroll down the list of installed applications, or use the search field, to locate Dual Monitor Driver
5. Click on Uninstall
